

PROPOSAL FOR LOBBY SHOW – GENERAL ENTRY FORM
Proposals must be received by the Guild no later than 3:30 PM on Feb. 23.

The Falmouth Artists Guild would like its Lobby Gallery to be a place to showcase a variety of excellent art for sale, that will produce income for the Guild and attract visitors, including new audiences. To generate ideas on how best to use this space in our new Art Center, we are making the Lobby Gallery available to members by soliciting for proposals for four separate time slots in 2010. The dates are as follows:

- A. 3/16 – 4/6 2010 B. 4/6 – 4/27 2010 C. 4/27 – 4/18 2010 D. 6/15 – 7/6 2010

All entrants must be a member of the Falmouth Artists Guild.

Proposals must include at least three artists and may include more than three artists.

All works must be the artist's own composition and not a copy of another painting, image or photo from a newspaper, magazine or the internet. Any art medium will be considered.

All works must be for sale. If a piece is sold, the artist may substitute another piece for sale.

Wall space available will be north and south sides of main lobby. Optional wall spaces are wall opposite door to stair to second floor and wall between main gallery door and classroom door.

Unless part of your proposal, the Guild reserves the right to use the horizontal display case and space for a limited number of three dimensional works by others who are Guild members. The Guild also reserves the right to have in the lobby such items as the tall red case and one or two Saori looms. The show will be hung by the Guild.

Please note that the Guild carries insurance not to exceed \$5,000 on any one item and an overall limit of \$50,000 on art work.

Due to limited storage space, a \$1 per day storage fee will be charged for works left after the pick-up date (last day of the show). Works not picked up 30 days after the pick-up date become the property of the Falmouth Artists Guild and may be disposed of as the Guild sees fit.
