

Annual Open Juried Photo Show Prospectus - 2017 April 27 - May 29

Receiving: Tuesday, April 25, 9:30am-4pm

Reception: Friday, May 5, 4-6pm. Everyone is cordially invited. Awards will be presented

during the reception.

Pick up Not accepted works should be picked up by Thursday, April 27, 9:30-4pm.

Dates: Accepted works should be picked up Tuesday, May 30, 9:30-4pm.

Please note: Due to limited storage space, a \$1 per day storage fee will be charged for works left after the pick up date. Works not picked up 30 days after the pick up date become the property of the Falmouth Artists Guild and

may be disposed of as the Guild sees fit.

Eligibility: Photographs not previously accepted into a Juried Show or exhibited at the

Falmouth Art Center. No more than **two** entries per artist will be accepted into the show; you may submit as many as you like for consideration. A list of accepted works will be posted on the website and at the Art Center. Accepted works are at the

discretion of the juror; it is a subjective process and the Artists Guild does not

influence the juror. Not all submissions are accepted in a juried show.

Fees: Members of the Falmouth Artists Guild: **\$10** per entry

Non-members: **\$15** per entry High Schoolers: **\$8** per entry

All the fees are non-refundable. Thank you for your support.

Sales: All entries must be valued, even if marked NFS (not for sale). The Guild gratefully

retains a commission of 30% from members and 50% from non-members for all

works sold.

Requirements: All works must be framed and wired for hanging (wired so work hangs flat

against the wall). Artwork to be hung cannot exceed 40" in any one direction. Sets

of photos in a series (of no more than 3) may be entered as one item at the discretion of the juror and will be judged as one entry. For pieces larger than 30 inches in either dimension, plexi-glass must be used instead of glass. All entries must be hand delivered to 137 Gifford St. and be ready for display. No clamped glass, cardboard, paste-on or metal sawtooth hangers will be accepted. Work not suitably framed and wired may be rejected for hanging with the loss of the

entry fee.
